




#### Melhourne City Campus

## Recommended Programs

#### Certificate IV + Diploma of Accounting (1 year)

 bookkeepers/BAS agents, assistant accountants, payroll officers or accounts clerks.

#### Diploma of Commerce

- a full year of study equivalent to the first year of a RMIT Bachelor of Business Program.
- Graduates can pursue careers in the private and public sectors, small and large enterprises and across the full range of industries.
- Graduates of the Diploma of Commerce are encouraged to progress to further studies in <u>business</u> or a related area to further enhance career opportunities.





# **English Requirement**

To study these programs you will need to complete one of the following English proficiency tests:

- IELTS (Academic): minimum overall band of 5.5 (with no individual band below 5.0)
- TOEFL (Internet Based Test IBT): minimum overall score of 50 (with minimum of 5 in Reading, 5 in Listening, 14 in Speaking and 15 in Writing)
- Pearson Test of English (Academic) (PTE (A)): minimum score of 42 (with no communication band less than 36)
- Cambridge English: Advanced (CAE): minimum of 162 with no less than 154 in any component.
- RMIT Upper Intermediate Requirement


