






WE ARE ESSEX

- Less than 7 miles from Base Jump Trampoline Park



Level 6 entry (final year) – up to 5 weeks hotel experience:

- For hotel management students work on project/problem for an external client (included putting together social media and marketing strategies, working on brand development and even contributing towards hotel launches
- For events management students organise a live event for an external client from start to finish (many students have been offered job opportunities with their project client)



- English language proficiency test certificate (if available). For a full list of accepted tests see www.essex.ac.uk/immigration/studies/english .aspx
- Personal statement
- CV (if you have full-time work experience)
- Reference letter (no need for postgraduate)








ACCOMMODATION
